We need YOUR current information!

Do you know what happens if OEA doesn't have your correct e-mail address?

- YOU will miss notifications for special events sponsored by OEA or your districts.
- YOU will miss information on important issues—like election information.
- As an elected delegate to the OEA and NEA, **YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE** RA materials. (NEA requires current e-mail addresses for these communications.)
- YOU will not receive electronic e-mail communications like *President to President* and *Member Matters*. These are timely communications that impact day-to-day activities.
- YOU will miss communications from your district leaders.

Do your part!

- Inform your UniServ office when you have a change in address, phone or e-mail, or update your record via the OEA website.
- Indicate a “primary” e-mail address that you check regularly. This is critical for future communications.
- As a local leader, please notify OEA when there is a change with a local president/co-president or vice president, etc.

Look for more OEA electronic communications to come to you. OEA wants to be your resource for accurate and timely information!
